In English, we have been analysing non-fiction texts. We have looked at different sentence structures and text structures and begun to use this in our own writing.

This has been a term of fractions in maths. We have learned how to manipulate fractions in order to compare, order and simplify. Most recently, we have been learning how to convert a fraction to a decimal.
